Dear Co-laborers:

Thank you for praying for the banquets that were held in California. Funds were raised for the Christian counseling center in Aguascalientes, Mexico. Plans are now being drawn for the construction of their own facility. Funds also came in for other needs, for which we praise God. We thank Ed and Velora Willems along with El Roy and Erma Ratzlaff for their work in coordinating the banquets.

We have been praying, along with our field director, Paul Unruh, concerning the difficulty of making ends meet on the field due to a lack of funds that we send them. Of course, we can only send funds that we receive. Let me tell you about how the funds are used in Mexico apart from the missionary staff support received.

## Child Evangelism

On the grounds of the Walter Gomez Evangelical Center in Pachuca is an office that promotes work among children. The leaders conduct training seminars for adults who desire to be

better Sunday school teachers and Bible club leaders. These seminars are given in various churches of Mexico. Bible clubs are used to reach many children who do not attend any church. The main source of income for this department is from donations passed on to them from EMM.



## Bible School in Pachuca

Some of the funds we send are used to supplement the Mexican professors' salaries. Even then, they do not receive what they could obtain elsewhere. They feel led of God to teach at the school, even if it means less pay. Most of the professors either pastor a church in the area or make trips to give conferences at other churches. Some of the funds are also designated for student scholarships. These are used to help the students who need it most.

## Correspondence Courses

Also at the WGE Center is an office for Bible correspondence courses. This office purchases courses already developed by other Christian organizations. Various levels of Bible correspondence lessons are sent free of charge to anyone who wants to learn more about the Bible. Children and adults take these courses. In some cases, there are pastors with very little schooling who take advantage of these courses to gain more knowledge of the Word. Magdalena Castillo, a graduate of our Bible school, heads this department and trains volunteers in various regions of Mexico. She also has taken training to be an advisor to online Bible study courses already developed. Funds from EMM help to support her and pay for the courses and the postage to send them.
