Over \$6000 was raised to help a Christian counseling center in Aguascalientes, Mexico, which was started by Vito Cruz, pastor of a CIEMAR church there. (CIEMAR is the Fellowship of Evangelical Missionary Churches with whom EMM co-labors.) This is a city of over a million where less than 2% are evangelical Christians.

My wife, Carol, and I will be presenting the Christian counseling center project again in three smaller banquets in California the third week in March.
